Do not:

- Use defamatory remarks or make false statements against others
- Post prejudiced comments or profanity
- Bully or make inflammatory remarks to other community members
- Post any teacher's content without their written permission
- Spam or flood the feeds or market your own or another's business, material unless you got approval. Email us for approval.

Consequences:

We will take action when we see someone violating these guidelines. Sometimes that just means giving someone a warning; other times it means revoking certain privileges or accounts entirely.
